Sunday Spotlight: a glance at a famous missionary's contributions

Gladys Aylward served as a missionary in China in the mid 1900s. Despite growing up in a period in which females had little opportunity to become educated, Gladys put her life on the line, using all her savings to travel to China and support herself. Mind you, she chose to do this after being rejected by China Inland Mission due to her limited education. She “joined veteran missionary Jeannie Lawson in Yangcheng, Shanxi Province” and “opened...the “Inn of the Eight Happinesses’...In the late 1930s, hostilities erupted between China and Japan, endangering lives across the region. Demonstrating extraordinary resolve, Aylward led more than 90 orphaned children to safety over perilous mountain terrain.” Nearer the end of her life, she moved to Taiwan to serve in similar ways: she created a safe, hospitable place for those in need and helped keep orphans safe, all while sharing God’s love for them.
