<p>8 <b>Joseph</b> (v22) <i>Gen 50:24-25</i> Had faith that the israelites would leave Egypt</p>	<p>9 <b>Moses' parents</b> (V 23) <i>Ex 2:1-2</i> Acted by faith by hiding him after he was born</p>	<p>10 <b>Moses</b> (v24) <i>Ex 2:11-15</i> By faith, he chose the oppression of God's people</p>	<p>11 <b>Moses</b> (v 27) <i>Ex 2:15</i> He left the land of Egypt, not fearing the king</p>	<p>12 <b>Moses</b> (v 28) <i>Ex 12:1-27; 31-41</i> By faith, he instructed people to keep Passover</p>	<p>13 <b>People of Israel</b> (v30) <i>Joshua 5:13-6:27</i> Marched around Jericho for 7 days</p>	<p>14 <b>People of Israel</b> (v29) <i>Exodus 13:17-14:21</i> Went through the Red Sea as though they were on dry land</p>
<p>15 <b>Rahab</b> (v31) <i>Josh 2:1-24 &amp;6:25</i> Was not destroyed with the people in her city he refused to obey God</p>	<p>16 <b>Gideon</b> (v32) <i>Judges 7:7-25</i> Defeated the Midianites with torches and jars</p>	<p>17 <b>Barak</b> (v32) <i>Judges 4:8-16</i> Confused Sisera and the Canaanites</p>	<p>18 <b>Samson</b> (v32) <i>Judges 13:1-16:31</i> Though weak in morality, God used him to defeat the Philistines</p>	<p>19 <b>Jephthah</b> (v32) <i>Judges 10:6-12:7</i> Victorious over the Amorites and the Ammonites</p>	<p>20 <b>David</b> (v32) <i>1 Samuel 16-11Kings 1</i> Loved God and for the most part lived an exemplary life of faith</p>	<p>21 <b>Samuel</b> (v32) <i>1 Samuel 1-15</i> Important transitional leader between judges and kings; he heard God's voice and did his will</p>
<p>22 <b>Daniel</b> (v33) <i>Daniel 6:1-23</i> Was not devoured by lions</p>	<p>23 <b>Elijah</b> (v34) <i>1 Kings 19:2 2 Kings 1-18</i> Escaped death</p>	<p>24 <b>Jeremiah</b> (v34) <i>Jeremiah 26:10-16 38:1-13</i> Escaped death</p>	<p>25 <b>Joshua</b> (v33) <i>Joshua</i> Over threw kingdoms</p>	<p>26 <b>Solomon</b> (v 32) <i>1 Kings 10:6-9</i> Ruled with justice</p>	<p>27 <b>Deborah</b>(v33) <i>Judges 4-5</i> Overthrew kingdoms</p>	<p>28 <b>Nehemiah</b> (v33) <i>Nehemiah</i> Ruled with justice</p>
