Life Groups are small groups of folks who get together regularly to encourage each other along the spiritual journey. We hang out, share a meal or just a cup of coffee and dessert as we get to know each other and learn about following Jesus. We'll do a Bible study or a Bible-based book study, pray for each other and even put our faith into action by serving others. Most Life Groups meet at the church on Sunday evenings, but some meet at other places or other times during the week.

**Bible Study Groups** are small groups that focus their attention on doing Bible study together, but always with practical life application. We get together on Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings.

To make it easy to connect, we provide open group signups twice during the year: In January for the Winter-Spring semester, and in August-September for the Fall semester. Most groups are open to new folks at any time, but during the semester you may wish to contact the group leader for more info


## Here's how you can get plugged in...
