Determining the Will of God

Many of us struggle to determine what the will of God is for our lives and for various situations that we encounter daily. In my search for this answer, I discovered this article that described these interesting ways to help us in our discernment process. Surely these practices can assist all of us on our journey with the Lord.

First, begin with prayer. Even though this sounds simple, and it is, through specific prayers God will show you His specific will for your life and this situation that you are encountering. Jeremiah 42:3 says to pray that the Lord your God will show us what to do and where to go.

Secondly, glorify God. When responding to any situation ask yourself, does this glorify God? God will never guide you to do something that will not give Him glory. Ask yourself, "Does this bless my relationship with my family? Does it make it possible for me to serve others? What will my attitude be if I do this? Give yourselves completely to God, for you were dead, but not you have new life. So, use your whole body as an instrument to do what is right for the glory of God. Romans 6:13

Thirdly, agree with Scripture. Does your decision and action agree with scripture? God gave us His Word to show us His will. You and I can trust the counsel of the Bible. You never have to ask God if it's His will for you to embezzle from your employer or dish the latest dirty detail about your neighbor. All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. 2 Timothy 3:16

Fourthly, be willing to wait. Be patient. God's will is worth the wait. Trust His timing. If something is God's will, He will guide you while you wait and bring it to pass. Don't rush it—when the timing is right God will let you know. Wait patiently for the Lord. Be brave and courageous, yes, wait patiently for the Lord. Psalm 27:14.

Finally, trust God to accomplish His will in your life and wait. God will do what He says He will do, and He will accomplish His will. Now all glory to God, who is able, through His mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more that we might ask or think. Ephesians 3:20

Not everything in life is clear. There will be times when you will do all the above and still be uncertain about God's direction for you. That's okay. You can trust that if God wants something specific in your life, He will guide you to it. If you've gone through the 5-step process and still have no clear answer.... just keep praying and serving God. Make a choice. The good news is if you are trusting and glorifying God with your life, you can move ahead confidently.




