


Men! Women! Kids! All are welcome!


There will be two hour shifts available during the hours of 10:00am to 8:00pm.





First of all, a great big thank you to all who have turned in their pledge cards for 2026. You have helped make the Stewardship campaign, "Grace in Action" a success. However, we have not heard from everyone - it is not too late to respond with your pledges. Your pledges fund our annual budget covering staff salaries, utilities, maintenance of the church and parsonage, and all expenses associated with running BBUMC and providing our services to the community. Over the next month, we will be setting our budget for the new year, so it is important to understand how much general funds donations are expected to cover our proposed budget.

The month of October was financially a bright spot for us. Our general fund receipts were \$29,937 compared to expenses of \$26,216, resulting in a monthly surplus of \$3,721. Through the first 10 months of the year, we now have a surplus of approximately \$18,000. In comparison, last year at this same time, we had a surplus of about \$10,000. Assuming this continues to year end, we will transfer funds to our Capital Improvement to cover some upcoming building expenses.


