

Create your own team or join with others the day of the event. Teams must have a licensed driver. Sign up on the One Stop or in the Narthex.








Halloween Trunk or Treat



Bible Study: The Chosen - Season 4

This fall we will be watching the fourth season of "The Chosen". The Chosen is a ground-breaking historical drama based on the life of Jesus Christ seen through the eyes of those who knew him. Set against the backdrop of Roman oppression in first-century Israel, the show shares an authentic and intimate look at Jesus' revolutionary life and teachings.

We will begin the showings on **TUESDAY** evenings (day of the week change) in the Quad rooms beginning on Sept. 23 and will show a new episode each week through Nov. 11 (total of 8 episodes).

You may choose how you would like to participate. You may bring your own dinner and watch the episode at the church from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, followed by a discussion of the episode from 7:00 - 8:00 pm. Or you may watch the episode on your own at home and come for the discussion from 7:00 - 8:00 pm. The discussion is also available via zoom. (You may watch the show on various streaming platforms such as The Chosen app, Amazon Prime, Peacock as well as others.)






