#### **UNITED WOMEN IN FAITH ANNUAL INGATHERING PROJECT-2025**

Big Beaver United Women in Faith have chosen for our annual ingathering project Holiday Bags for low income families who have children in the Detroit Public School Pre-Kindergarten program, Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP). The GSRP offers services to four-year-old children and their families with the goal of assisting the families in meeting their needs. Every child wants a Christmas gift. School social workers get the names of the five neediest families in each classroom. The goal of the social workers is to have a Holiday Bag for each of those five children. Over the years, they have managed to have a Holiday Box/Bag for only three of the five children. We met with three of the school social workers who encouraged us to participate in this program. They suggested putting the items in a bag, and the bag can be cloth or paper. The items requested for each bag include size 4 or 5:

One (1) cap and mitten set

One (1) long sleeved shirt (white or light blue)

One (1) pullover sweater/sweatshirt

One (1) set of underwear

One (1) book

One (1) pair of slacks (navy, black or khaki)

One (1) toy (age app. for a 4 year old)

One (1) pair of socks

One (1) skirt/skort (navy, black)

It is our goal that each bag will contain all the above, but they will accept any individual items as well.

We will begin collecting the bags in August through September. Starting on August 3, there will be a bin in the Narthex for collection of the bags or individual items. The bags will be distributed by the school social workers at Christmastime.







#### **Reduce the Risk**

#### **Becky's Book Spotlights: Robert Dugoni**

This month I am recommending three books by Robert Dugoni that I thoroughly enjoyed and wanted to share with you. These books appeal to both men and women.

"The Extraordinary Life of Sam Hell" is a coming-of-age novel that follows Sam Hill, born with ocular albinism (red eyes), as he navigates childhood, adolescence, and adulthood, learning to embrace his unique identity and find his place in the world. The story explores themes of faith, friendship, forgiveness, and the power of love, as Sam grapples with bullying, societal expectations, and personal tragedy. He's supported by his mother, father, and two close friends, who help him overcome challenges and discover the true meaning of an extraordinary life.

"The World Played Chess" is a coming-of-age story that explores themes of innocence, PTSD, and the impact of war across generations. It follows 18-year-old Vincent Bianco in 1979, who works with a Vietnam veteran named William, and contrasts their experiences with that of a third character, a young man in 2015. The novel uses interwoven timelines and a journal kept by William during the war to examine the long-lasting effects of trauma and the search for identity.

"Hold Strong" is a novel based on true events and real people. It is told through alternating perspectives, showing the contrasting experiences of Sam as a POW and Sarah as a codebreaker. Sam's experiences in the Philippines, particularly his time as a prisoner of war showcasing the atrocities committed by the Japanese. Sarah's work as a codebreaker is also portrayed, including the moral dilemmas she faces when her work intersects with Sam's fate.

This fall we will be watching the fourth season of "The Chosen". The Chosen is a ground-breaking historical drama based on the life of Jesus Christ seen through the eyes of those who knew him. Set against the backdrop of Roman oppression in first-century Israel, the show shares an authentic and intimate look at Jesus' revolutionary life and teachings.

We will begin the showings on **TUESDAY** evenings (day of the week change) in the Quad rooms beginning Sept. 23rd and will show a new episode each week through Nov. 11th (total of eight episodes).






