August Prayer Guide

Theme: Always Ready

Genesis 24:27

I being in the way, the Lord led me...

Week 1: Pray and Prepare to Be Led

Genesis 24:1-14

This week, focus your prayers on preparing to follow God's leading:

- Prepare your heart Seek a heart that is humble, open, and sensitive to God's direction.
- **Prepare your soul** Spend time in His presence, cultivating spiritual readiness.
- Prepare your mind Ask God to align your thoughts and expectations with His truth.

Being ready begins with being prepared.

Week 2: Pray and Position to Be Led

Genesis 24:1-14

This week, ask God to help you position yourself to respond to His leading:

- Position the things you need Place what's essential within reach, spiritually and practically.
- Position the things you don't need Remove distractions and hindrances from your path.
- **Position what He needs** Surrender your time, resources, and gifts to be used for His glory.

Being ready means living intentionally and attentively.

Week 3: Pray and Personalize Being Led

Genesis 24:11-14

This week, make your readiness personal and specific:

- **Personalize your preparation** Ask God what He is preparing *you* for.
- **Personalize your position** Consider how *your* posture, availability, and obedience matter.
- **Personalize your praise** Praise Him for *your* unique journey and testimony.

Being ready means knowing that God's leadership looks different for each of us.

Week 4: Pray and Proclaim Being Led

Genesis 24:27

Blessed be the Lord God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his truth...

This week, give voice to God's faithfulness:

- **Proclaim how good He is** Declare His goodness in your present season.
- **Proclaim how good He was** Remember and speak of His faithfulness in the past.
- **Proclaim how good He is going to be** Anticipate His continued goodness with confident hope.

Being ready includes boldly sharing the story of how the Lord leads.

May this month be a journey of preparation, positioning, personal surrender, and joyful proclamation as we stay "always ready" for the Lord to lead.
