Your Session met in person for a called meeting on Tuesday morning, November 19, 2024, the regular monthly meeting. During the meeting the Elders:

Received an inspiration from our Moderator Rev. Joel Moody— Mark 13:1-8. Temples — the church body or our own body is a temple. Where is our hope when your temple falls? With Jesus, he gives us hope when something fails.

Educational point – From the Book of Order – The Foundations of Presbyterian Polity Chapter 3 – Principles of Order and Government - God is Lord of the Conscience.

Received a report from our Pastoral Nominating Committee (PNC).

The Deacons continue to contact their church groups monthly.

Received reports from all committees.

- -Buildings and Grounds Work to take down the chimney in Westminster building and other projects has begun. The Fall Work Day was successful.
- -Christian Education Understanding Your Grief the fall session is completed and the new session will begin Tuesday, January 14, 2025 at 7 p.m. at 111 W. Washington Street in Goshen.
- -Congregational Life and Ministry The third Smock Cluster Fund activity is planned for Wednesday, December 4, at Pigeon & The Hen Pottery in South Bend. Cost is \$5 to attend. Sign-up sheet is in the office.
- -Finance continues to meet monthly with our Treasurer.
- -Mission Committee Samaritan's Purse (Operation Christmas Child boxes) will be received in November as the fall mission.
- -Outreach update in the sound booth is continuing, print media reviewed, and updating the website
- -Personnel Committee Second interviews regarding the Administrative Assistant position have taken place.
- -Worship Plans have been made for Advent. Decorating of the Church will be November 30 starting at 10 a.m.



**PER CAPITA** is an annual per member fee a congregation pays to their area Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly to support our denomination's work in mission, evangelism, education and administration. Through your per capital giving, which is over and above your yearly pledge, the Presbytery of Wabash Valley helps congregations with transitions and resources for programming and planning, cares for pastoral leaders and their families, helps prepare people for service as pastoral leaders, and provides funds for special projects or needs of our congregations. There is a designated amount per member. **In 2024, the amount per member is \$43.62**. **In 2025, the amount per member is \$44.66**. There is a line item for Per Capita on the church's offering envelope. **Per capita brochures, which explain where your dollars go, are on the table outside of the office.** 

It would be of immense help to this congregation and our operations budget to please pay your annual membership fee as soon as possible. There are some in our congregation for whom paying per capita is difficult. If you are able to contribute per capita for those who might not be able to pay, your generosity would be greatly appreciated. Thank you to those who have already paid their per capita, and those who have also given an extra portion. The total amount due is paid whether or not each member contributes their individual amount. 
Early Voting—Monday, November 4, 8:00 am—12:00 noon
