

Dear Felida Family,

There will be three venues to choose from. Please choose the worship venue that best fits your situation and tolerance of risk. Worship services will last about 45 minutes.

Following the guidelines we will be able to seat 54 persons (at 25% capacity) in the Auditorium. This will be first come, first seated. If we reach our capacity you may be asked to move to overflow or to the Church Gym (Option #2).

Children's church will still take place with masks required.

Option #1: In-Home Livestream (Lowest risk)

Description: Connect to our worship service via livestream on your personal computer, mobile device or TV.

Appropriate for:

- Anyone with symptoms of a viral illness or who has been exposed to someone with COVID within the last 14 days; OR...
- Those in high-risk groups for serious COVID complications; OR... those with a lower tolerance of risk for potential infection.

Option #2: Church Gym Livestream (masks required- No exceptions)

Description: Join with other worshippers in the gym to participate in the worship service via livestream on a large projection screen.

Appropriate for:

- Those without illness symptoms; AND...
- who want to worship in the presence of others; AND... who have a somewhat higher tolerance of risk for potential infection

Option #3: Church Auditorium with Worship Team (masks required -except those with medical/personal reasons)

Description: Join with other worshippers in the auditorium to participate in the worship service with the worship team present. The speaker and vocalist will not be masked but other precautions will be in place (social distancing, masks will be available if forgotten).

Appropriate for:

- Those without illness symptoms; AND...
- who want to worship in the presence of others with congregational singing; AND... who have a higher tolerance of risk for potential infection.

Some people may have health conditions or circumstances that make wearing a cloth face covering difficult or dangerous. As we navigate through these difficult times, let us all be considerate of each others choices and safety, bearing with one another in love (Ephesians 4:1-3).
