- Removal of Hymnals, Pew Bibles, and other supplies from Pews
- No greeting time, handshakes, hugging
- Offering boxes by PGI Board and exit
- Social distancing at all times
- Limited access to restrooms

11:00 am– Worship Service in Person

**Adult Sunday School & Small Groups** meet in larger rooms with social distancing. Room reservations required.

**Wednesday Prayer Meeting and Senior Adults** may begin with social distancing.

**180 Youth** abbreviated schedule with precautions & social distancing. See Facebook for schedule updates.

#### Sunday Morning Precautions same except:

- Restrooms open with extra cleaning during services

#### PG Kids\*

- Sunday AM Nursery open with limited # of kids per room (infant to 3 years old)
- PGKids Worship at 11am with social distancing– registration required
- No Kids Sunday School
- Kids Mission Groups Meet Outside

### What you need to know...

In cooperation with local, state, and national guidelines, Piney Grove will move to re-open its public gatherings for worship in a three step approach. This approach will be complementary to the guidelines set forth by the North Carolina Governor's Office and the local Wake County Health Department. The initiation of each phase will be determined by data instead of dates by Piney Grove staff and leaders. In addition, (and most importantly) this three step approach will adhere to the following theological principles set forth by God's Word:

*1. Love God and love your neighbor*  
Matthew 22:37-39

*2. Commit to meet together*  
Hebrews 10:25

*3. Protect the vulnerable.*  
James 1:27

### What You Can Expect From Piney Grove

- Single Entrance & Exit to limit crossflow of traffic.
- Hand sanitizing stations and masks will be provided.
- 6-foot social distancing will be in place.
- Designated seating in sanctuary not to exceed limited capacity.
- Reduced time in worship services- 30-45 minutes (Step 1 & 2).
- Disinfection before & after every service.
- No nursery services (Step 1).
- No handouts (i.e. bulletins) at the service. Information will be shared via email bulletin and on the screens.
- Hands-free collection boxes for tithes and offerings.

### What We Need from You

- Pre-Register Online for the service you plan to attend.
- Sanitize hands before entering the building at stations provided.
- Sit together as a family and follow directions from ushers for seating and dismissal.
- Please wear a mask while inside the building.
- Resist physical contact, hugs, handshakes, or gathering inside the building.
- If you test positive for COVID and recently attended a Sunday service, please inform a member of the church staff. Confidentiality will be maintained.

### For everyone's health and safety, please worship online from home if...

- You have been diagnosed with Covid-19, had close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19, or have been advised to quarantine.
- Within the past 7 days, you have experienced fever, chills, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new cough, new loss of taste or smell, or do not generally feel well.
