Worship Elements

The flowers on the communion table are given to the glory of God and provided by the Agape & Friendship Classes in memory of Reverend Nancy M. Brannon.

Rev. Brannon served as Associate Minister of Children at Fifth Avenue Baptist Church from August 1989 to March 2009. To children and adults alike, she embodied all that a minister should be: a friend, a spiritual mentor, an encourager, an advisor, and a confidante. It was clear to all who knew her that she was a deeply devoted follower of Jesus Christ, and through her ministry, many adults and children came to know Him.

Rev. Brannon earned both her bachelor’s degree (Bowling Green State University) and master’s degree (The Ohio State University) in education, and she later completed additional studies at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. This blend of education and theology made her uniquely gifted for her dual role at FAB as both Children’s Minister and Daycare Director. Under her leadership, the daycare flourished, and the children’s ministry blossomed. She established cherished traditions such as Vacation Bible Camp at Camp Ona and Wild Wonderful Wednesdays, which filled summers with joy and laughter. Her desk was always adorned with children’s drawings, coloring pages, and handmade bouquets—tokens of their love for her.

FAB had the honor of ordaining Rev. Brannon to the ministry. She was the first woman ordained in the Guyandotte Baptist Association and, quite possibly, in the West Virginia Baptist Convention. During her two decades of service, she officiated countless weddings and funerals, offering comfort and guidance through life’s most sacred moments.

Today, on All Saints’ Sunday, we give thanks for the life and faithful service of Reverend Nancy M. Brannon and for the lasting impact she made on this church and community.
