INTRODUCTION ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Fifth Avenue Baptist Church,

It is with great excitement that your Pastoral Search Committee announces that we have selected a candidate to recommend to our church family. Our Pastoral Call Weekend is scheduled to be held November 14th - 16th, culminating in a congregational vote at the end of worship on Sunday, November 16th. We will provide a schedule for the Call Weekend in the coming days.

Our candidate grew up on the edge of Appalachia and has an appreciation for Huntington's influence as a city in the greater Appalachian region. He graduated with an M.Div. from a Baptist seminary and is currently pursuing a Doctor of Ministry degree. He has been serving his current church as the senior pastor for over 12 years and has over 15 years of ministry experience. He and his wife have two young children. Additionally, this candidate was recommended to the Center for Healthy Churches by multiple people related to Fifth Avenue Baptist Church.

The Pastoral Search Committee has had numerous conversations with the candidate and is unanimous in its decision to recommend him to the congregation for a vote to call him to serve as the next pastor of Fifth Avenue Baptist Church.

We understand that this brief introduction only whets your appetite for further information about our recommendation. Unfortunately, due to the reality of today's social media and internet communications, we feel that it is prudent not to disclose any identifying details within this letter which is being shared with the congregation both electronically and by mail. Our candidate is currently serving another church family, and any premature revelation of his identity could have significant and unintended consequences. 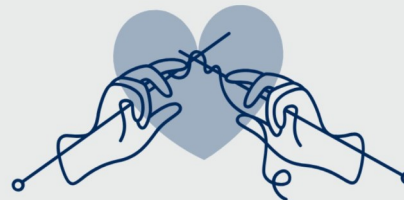
