**LIFE LINE SCREENING AT EMANUEL IN JULY!** Do you have high cholesterol or high blood pressure? Have members of your family suffered from these ailments? Do you have a poor diet? Life Line uses ultrasound technology to view the plaque buildup in your carotid arteries, the main arteries that carry blood to the brain. Blockages of these arteries are a leading cause of stroke.
