Motion carried unanimously.</p> <p><b>Treasurer’s Report:</b> Treasurer Norman Winsleman presented the financial report for July 2025: Inflows: \$8,338.00 Outflows: \$11,164.74 Ending Balance: \$54,237.93</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A note was made that the account balance was \$68,218.32 on January 1, 2025, current balance September 1 was \$54,238.93 a difference of \$13,979.39. Conversation about property and workers’ comp insurance indicated the budgeted amount of \$7,800 will be closer to \$10,000 this year after July renewal increases.</li><li>• Motion carried to approve the Treasurer’s report.</li></ul> <p><b>Trustee’s Report:</b> Waiting for roof repair to be completed. Insurance will not be used for the repair. Propane Tanks have been placed on the new concrete pads and supply has been reconnected and pressure tested.</p> <p><b>Pastor’s Report:</b> Pastor will attend LCMC Conference Oct 3-5. A youth group retreat is planned for Oct. 17-19 in Alexandria MN. Pastor discussed visitations for the month.
