

Directions: Read each pair of verses. In each pair, there is one verse from the Old Testament (before Jesus) and one from the New Testament (Jesus' birth and after.) The Old Testament verses each predict something specific that would be true about the Messiah. This prediction is called a prophecy.

After you read each pair, record the prediction (prophecy) that came true in Jesus. The first has been completed for you.
