

a place for kids and adults to gather with friends, old and new, at the table with Jesus.

Our first lesson in February centered on The Wise and Foolish Builder. We started the evening by standing on one foot first on a rock and then on a pile of sand. We talked about which material made us feel more secure and thus was a better foundation.

The children each had a part in telling the story from placing the rock or sand in a pan to pouring water (rain) over the 'house' on the rock and sand. They loved watching the sand wash away and the house fall down.

The children wrote wise choices on pictures of rocks and poor choices on pictures of sand to put in their binder books. Ask to see their books!

During craft time the children dot painted a Valentine theme on white lunch bags. I then gave them a heart cookie to put in their bag.

On Feb. 18 we heard the parable of the Rich Fool. We started the evening by talking about the difference in "wants" and "needs". We all agreed that when we have more than we need the best thing to do is to share some of our bounty.

At the beginning of Bible Exploration time I gave the kids two pieces of chocolate bar. We then discussed how they were alike and different. We all agreed that basically they tasted the same. I then discussed how one was made with Fair Trade chocolate and the other wasn't. We discussed being fair to the workers. They heard the parable of the rich fool who instead of sharing his wealth, hoarded it. He then died and was unable to enjoy his wealth. The children helped come up with ideas for ways to share our own wealth- donate toys and clothing that has been outgrown, giving to the food bank, giving money to organizations such as Habitat for Humanity and local food banks. During craft time we made barn banks. The children were encouraged to put change in the box and **then donate the collected money** to an organization that helps meet the needs of those without.
