## PRIVACY POLICY

### Overview

This Privacy Policy describes how and when Coastline Church (“we” or “us”) collects, uses and shares your personal information when you visit or use this website. If you do not agree with the terms of this Policy, please do not use this website or disclose information to us.

### Information Collection and Use

#### Overview

We may collect from you both anonymous information and personally identifiable information. Anonymous information is aggregate data that we may use to optimize the efficiency of this website. Anonymous information does not identify you individually. Personally identifiable information is information you voluntarily provide to us that personally identifies you, such as your first and last name, physical address, email address or phone number.

#### Third Party Services

When you visit this website, we may use third party services such as *Google Analytics*. By doing so, we may gather information such as the date and time of your visit, the pages of this website you visit, and the type of browser and operating system you use to access this website. All information obtained from these third party services are anonymous, so no personally identifiable information is received by us in this manner. #### Social Media Features
