To be listed as a FaithGroup, it must have 2/3 member/partners from FaithWestwood – and must be led by member/partner.

Family Ministry <u>and</u> **Youth Ministry** / Ministries focus on children, youth, & their families. Also look for ways to serve in **Family Ministry**.

Missions / There are many Mission projects <u>and</u> community partnerships that the church supports offering numerous ways in which individuals, families, and/or groups can serve!

Small Groups / FaithWestwood's **Small Groups** allow for fellowship as people gather with common interests like arts & crafts, creation care, gardening and much more!

Sunday Mornings: Hospitality, Worship, Music Groups / As we provide hospitality and worship on Sunday mornings, there are many opportunities to serve to "nurture a community of hospitality where all are welcomed, encouraged, and connected."

Coffee Team – (opening & closing teams) – make the coffee and set-up the coffee station before 9 am, then clean up after 10:45 service
