

Bishop Cedrick D. Bridgeforth announces the appointment of Rev. Elizabeth McVicker to Trinity & St. Paul's United Methodist Churches in Idaho Falls, Idaho, effective March 1, 2024, in a three-quarter time position.

Rev. McVicker is an ordained elder in the Mountain Sky Conference of The UMC. Rev. Kathy Neary, will continue her parttime, interim ministry through the end of March. The GNW cabinet's commitment to provide leadership in Idaho Falls once each month will continue through May.

PASTORAL TRANSITION

It is so exciting to welcome you, Rev. Elizabeth, to the Idaho Falls Methodists family. We are looking forward to beginning this new journey with you.

I've been part of the Methodist family for less than 10 years; this is my first pastoral transition as part of the Church Admin Council. On February 25th Rev. Kathleen Weber, District Superintendent in the Pacific NW Conference, presented an interactive workshop at Trinity. One part of the workshop dealt with Pastoral Transition as it related to the Prayer of Examen.

I'd never heard that term before, so I Googled "prayer of examen". It was developed by St. Ignatius of Loyola, a 15th-century Basque, who became the founder of the Jesuit Order of priests. To greatly simplify the process of prayerful reflection it involves five steps: give thanks to God, ask God to enlighten you, examine the day, seek forgiveness, and resolve to change.

Rev. Kathleen took this one step further in looking at Pastoral Transition for Idaho Falls. The questions she asked each of us to think about were very thought-provoking.

The questions were:

- What do you celebrate about this interim time? (for example, learning new ways of looking at Idaho Falls Methodism and working with Trinity)
- What do you grieve about this interim time? (one comment was grieving because the church I've always known no longer exists)
- What do you hope for in this upcoming pastoral transition?

I'm sure you all will agree that we are blessed to have someone with Rev. Elizabeth's experience to lead us in spiritual growth and deepen our connection with God.



RCCM UPDATE FEBRUARY 20, 2024

The Community Food Basket served 1,374 families in January, which included 3,195 adults, 2,260 kids, 293 Seniors, 40 homeless and 249 Babies. 3735 Diapers were distributed.

A funding source needs to be found for diapers if it is to be continued. The Souper Bowl brought in 41,769 pounds of food between Skyline and Idaho Falls.

December and January are the biggest fund raisers of the year. There will be a warehouse sale in March. (Costco returns and left overs)

The Senior Center no longer has the funds to provide week end meals, the community Food Basket provided 150 boxes of food to be delivered to fill in the gap.

A new floor is covering in place to thanks to Hillcrest basketball and football teams which is non-skid.

Attendance at Little Church in the Pines is up. There are 193 permanent residents in Island Park. The search continues for a pastor with the biggest obstacle being housing. The average price for housing is \$790,000.

Plan on attending the Lenten Services, St. Paul's will be hosting on March 13. The Soup Kitchen is approaching 1,000,000 meals being served soon.
