

I am sad that this is my last newsletter article for you all, as my time as your part-time, interim, two Sundays-a-month pastor is coming to an end. March 10 will be my last Sunday with you, and I then return full-time to my regular job. For the last eight months, it has been my honor to work with you as we try to imagine the future of United Methodism in Idaho Falls. We have had a wild and precious time together!

We have accomplished a lot in this short time. I am most impressed with the Trinity and St. Paul's congregations' renewed sense of being in ministry together. So many of you stepped up your commitment to leading our congregations in this time when it was crucial to do so. We have discovered that God is calling us in so many ways to proclaim God's love and grace with renewed energy to all of Idaho Falls. Answering God's call together makes so much sense, and it is a lot of fun too!

As I have been telling Rev. Elizabeth about our ministry here, I found myself saying again and again, "Oh, you are going to love this person! They are so much fun to work with!" I won't be contacting you, and I trust that you will bring all your pastoral needs to Rev. Elizabeth. I'm sure that sometime in the future (at least a couple of years from now) we will see each other again, and share fond memories of this year of experimentation.

One last memory: a couple of weeks ago at Trinity we found ourselves unexpectedly without a piano player for our Sunday service. I had convinced myself that we would just do without music for one Sunday. Lo and behold, Marilyn Taylor came waltzing down the aisle (using her walker of course) and said she could fill in for us. I didn't even know she played the piano! Her kind offering of her musical talents was the perfect example of how so many of you have demonstrated your love for these two churches. May we all go forward, becoming the people God has made us capable of being!
