A Word from our Administrative Council Chair

As we move closer to our disaffiliation date of June 30th, 2023, I want to ask the congregation to prayerfully consider a contribution to our disaffiliation fund.

Total costs to disaffiliate have come in at \$86,325.75. Thanks to rising interest rates, this amount is dramatically less than first estimated. These costs include pension liabilities, 15 months apportionments, lawyer fees, and new church signage/ hymnals.

This amount will have to be paid no later than 30 days after May 21st which is when our disaffiliation will be voted on by the Annual Conference. Thanks to your contributions, we have already raised \$23,000 towards this goal!

We do ask you to prayerfully consider giving to our disaffiliation fund above and beyond your normal tithe. Thank you in advance for your generosity!

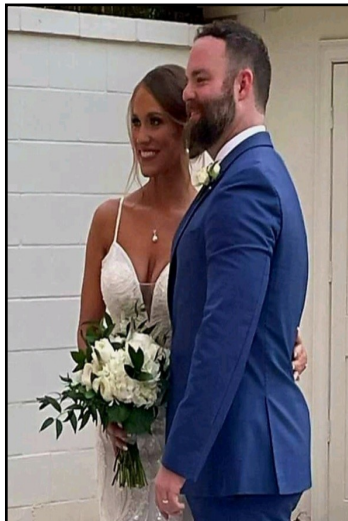
