The Minister of Families will help us to fulfill this missions by:

Being responsible for providing leadership in planning, conducting, and evaluating a Christ-centered ministry for Kindergarten through High School aged students and their families.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

45% Plan, conduct and coordinate the Church ministry to students based on the needs and expectations of the church. The program and activity planned must be developed in cooperation with the Pastor and organizations of the church (e.g., Sunday School, Missions, Worship, Youth and Children Teams). All Programs shall have as their goals: **Worship** appropriate to the age group, **Equipping** through Bible study, missions, discipleship, social and spiritual growth and **Proclaiming** the Gospel to the unsaved.

- 10% Recruit, enlist and train volunteers to serve in the Student Ministry.
- 10% Counsel students, parents and volunteers. Effectively communicate with students, parents, volunteers and Church Staff.
- 5% Arrange the set-up and clean-up of any materials and equipment used in these efforts.
- 5% Advise the Pastor and Staff concerning the needs and requirements of the Student Ministry.
- 5% Make budget recommendations for all Student Ministry Areas to the Finance Team and operate within the approved Church budget.
- 20% Perform other Ministerial duties as assigned.

Necessary Knowledge and Skills:

A strong commitment to winning the lost student to Christ. Must possess a patience and love and have the knowledge and skills to relate to and lead students in a church setting.

Basic Qualifications:

Must have experienced personal Salvation. Must have experienced a personal calling by God to Family Ministries and be or be willing to be Ordained by a local Church. Must be a graduate or seeking to graduate with training in this field. A Master's degree from a conservative seminary is preferred. Experience in a similar position is a must.
