IT'S TIME TO WAKE UP

Early one morning, a father walked into his son's room and flipped on the light. He said in a patient voice, "Son, it's time for you to wake up and get ready for school." His son rolled toward the wall and pulled the covers over his head. In a more insistent voice, the father again said, "Son, it's time for you to wake up and get ready for school." "I don't like school" the son replied. The son said, "I don't like school, it's boring, and the kids don't like me." Then the father said, "You may not like school and you may find it boring. And even if the kids don't like you, it's time for you to wake up and get ready for school." Then the father said, "You must wake and get ready for school, because you are the Assistant Principal of the school, and must wake up and get going!"

This humorous interchange comes from a book titled, "Awareness" by the late Dr. Anthony De Mello. He suggests that we are walking around asleep, unaware of our surroundings, even when we believe that we are awake. Further, he says we are sleeping through the most important moments of life. If we would only "wake up and become aware of life around us" we may find moments of clarity, peace and awareness.

Living unaware of life's joy is just like sleepwalking. When we sleepwalk through life, we tend to operate on "autopilot," and it's just like simply going though the motions. If we would only wake up and become aware of life we will find experiences of unspeakable joy awaiting us. The Bible also encourages us to wake up, "Besides this, you know what time it is, how it is now the moment for you to wake from sleep. For salvation is nearer to us now than when we became believers; the night is far gone, the day is near" (Romans 13:11-12a).

There is more joy and wonder in life that we miss when we drift through life half-asleep. Let's wake up, get our self engaged in life, and become aware of everything that is going on around us. May the Lord bless you in the days ahead.


