TAKING TIME TO JUST BE

Within each of us there is an urging to slow down, reflect and to recall the deeper things in life. Things such as the sound of a light rain on an old tin roof, the comforting smell of fresh-baked bread, or the warmth of an old-timey quilt on a cool mountain evening. Many of us miss these simple enjoyments because of the busyness and the muchness of life. The rush of every day rolls by, and the task lists get longer and longer. It seems to be more common recently for people to keep going and going while all along losing the purpose in all the doing.

You may recall the creation account in the book of Genesis, "then the Lord God formed the human from the dust of the earth, and blew life's breath into nostrils. The human became a living being" (Genesis 2:7). You may quickly note that God did not make us human doings, we are, in fact, created as "beings." If we look at the Genesis account closely, we may see that the more we live our true nature as beings, the more in alignment we are with the beauty and wonder of God's incredible design for us.

So, when we make time in our busy schedules to revisit our true nature as beings we may encounter God in a clearer and more profound way. Think of it:

God spoke to the prophet Elijah not in the blast of the of the wind, not in the clamor of the earthquake, not in the might of the fire. God spoke to Elijah in the intimate sound of sheer silence. We may only hear the voice of God in the sound of sheer silence when we finally quiet our own inner voice long enough to her One speaking words of comfort.

Ponder these comforting words from Psalm 46:10:


