#### YOU'RE FREE TO LET GO

Many of us are what are known as "pack rats." Maybe you know what a pack rat is: accumulating unnecessary things with the hope of needing it someday. "Better to have and not need rather than to need and not have" is the mantra of diehard pack rats. It may be true that someday you might find a use for something discarded, but most often, when the need arises a better alternative might appear.

How much have you accumulated over the years? Are there things lying around that you cannot remember where they came from? What have you stepped over or around for years that you wish to be rid of? These questions relate to material things, but the real question relates to spiritual things that we accumulate such as habits, life patterns, behaviors, thoughts and dreams, and choices. We accumulate spiritual things much as if we gather material things. Some things we gather intentionally, but other things we acquire almost without notice.

Those spiritual things that cling to us without notice are subtle reminders that life is intentional. Each day is an calculated endeavor. It may be a day of struggle, a day of refreshment, a day of trial or a day of leisure, but either way, each day is an intentional day. You may even accomplish what you intended to accomplish on a given day, and other days might bring no accomplishment at all. However, each day adds stuff to life. The stuff that accumulates can be either beneficial like joyful memories of a happier time. On the other hand, this stuff can be destructive like old habits that bring misery on self and others.

Now is the time to let go of old tired ways that make life a chore. What is it that you can let go of that might make your life more enjoyable? Maybe an old habit harms body and soul. Maybe a thought pattern keeps others at arm's length. Maybe it is accumulated years of running from God. Now is the time to let go.

Letting go of some old things might lighten the burden that you carry. Now is the time to take spiritual inventory of things that you have accumulated and consider those things in the way of your relationship with others and your relationship with God. You are free to let go. God bless you in the days to come.


