Food Items: Cereal and Grits

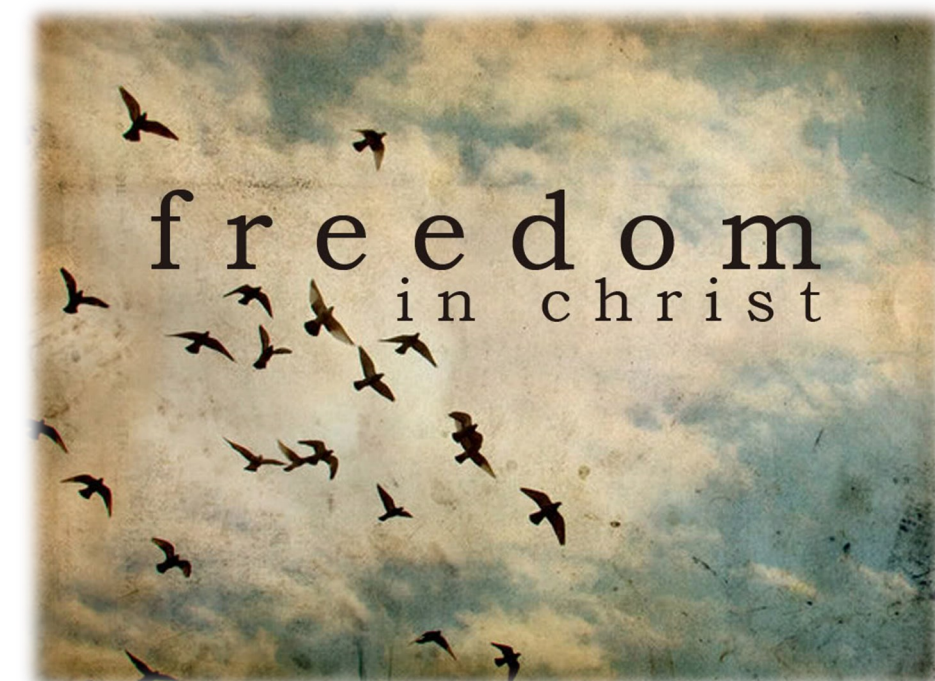
