9 Principles to Live by...

Acts 20:32 – Grace builds us up and encourages us...

"So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified."

Romans 1:5 – Grace gives us the obedience to the faith...

"Through Him we have received grace and apostleship for obedience to the faith among all nations for His name."

1st Peter 5:12 – Grace allows us to stand...

"By Silvanus, our faithful brother as I consider him, I have written to you briefly, exhorting and testifying that this is the true grace of God in which you stand."

2nd Corinthians 4:15 – Grace causes thanksgiving to abound in our life...

"For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God."

2nd Timothy 2:1 – Grace gives us the ability to be strong...

"You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus."

2nd Corinthians 12:9-10 – Grace enables us to trust Him, even in our infirmities...

"And He said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong."

Titus 2:11-12 – Grace keeps us from sin and teaches us how to live Godly lives...

"For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age."

Hebrews 12:28 – Grace enables us to serve...

"Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear."

Hebrews 13:9 – Grace establishes our heart...

"Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them."
