- 4. What are some of the external circumstances that caused the Hebrew Christians to waver in "the confession of our hope"? What pressures are causing you to waver? How does v.23 speak to those pressures?
- 5. How would you summarize the call to build community in vv. 24-25? What makes building this kind of community so difficult? Why is listening such an important part of Gospel-shaped community?
- 6. What evidences of God's grace can you share from your life together with the church family at North City Presbyterian Church?
