UPDATE ON ANDREW BRUNSON

Turkish media reported on July 25 that Andrew Brunson has been moved from prison and put under house arrest. The Second High Penel Court in Izmir issued the ruling which also included an international travel ban meaning Brunson cannot leave the country. “We are very thankful for this court ruling to allow Andrew to be detained at his house instead of behind bars, where he has spent 21 months,” said Jeff Jeremiah, EPC Stated Clerk. “At the same time, this trial is not over. He is still facing serious charges so we press on praying, fasting and advocating for Andrew.”
