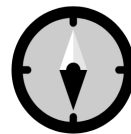
Mission Focus

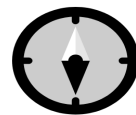

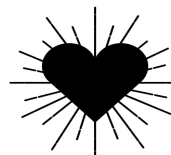
