We are thankful to have you join us for our Sunday morning worship. Everyone is welcome at Park Church.

We'd love it if everyone filled out the basic information on the communication card, detach it from the bulletin and turn it in to the collection plates during the offering.

Many songs we use come from the red "Lift Up Your Heart" hymnal. They are available at the Worship Center entrances for those who would like to follow in the hymnal.

The Center for Women in Transition's mission is to respond to, reduce, and prevent domestic and sexual violence. This mission will be achieved through education, collaboration, and advocacy, with crisis and supportive services to victims and survivors.
