Q & A will be held following worship this morning. The Deacons will talk about some of their new ideas, including a summer service day.

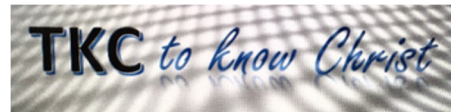

In Mark 1, John the Baptist comes preaching a baptism of repentance and forgiveness of sins. This is the same message that Peter preaches at Pentecost. As we enter into the season of Lent,

let us consider the impact that these weeks in the life/death/resurrection of Christ make on our lives. Give thanks to God, Who, in Christ and by the Spirit, makes our repentance effective and our baptism powerful!

Ash Wednesday service will be held this Wednesday evening at 6:30. Come for a special time of worship as we begin the Lenten season.

Praise Team rehearsal will begin at 7:00 instead of 6:30 on Wednesday evening because of the Ash Wednesday service.

Next Sunday is "spring ahead" week. We will begin a new Lent sermon series looking at the seven statements of Jesus from the cross. We will also have a couple of special guests for an adult Sunday School after the worship service. Eric and Jordan Achterhof currently live in Zeeland, but will soon be moving to Toronto to start a new church and ministry to college students. They come from a college ministry in Ann Arbor that has been very effective in reaching out to students. Their story will be one to challenge and inspire.
