We are thankful to have you join us for our Sunday morning worship. Everyone is welcome at Park Church.

We'd love it if everyone filled out the basic information on the communication card, detach it from the bulletin and turn it in to the collection plates during the offering.

Many songs we use come from the red "Lift Up Your Heart" hymnal. They are available at the Worship Center entrances for those who would like to follow in the hymnal.

Nursery is available in our lobby area. It is staffed by screened and approved volunteers. Children ages 3 - 2nd grade are dismissed halfway through the service to go to their Worship Centers. This morning Laura Hunderman and Jane Genzink will teach.

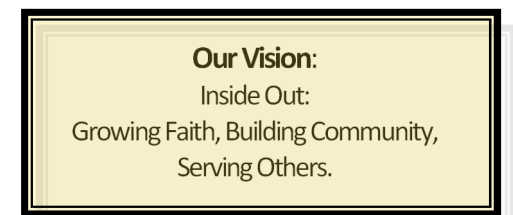
