WHAT IS THE INSTITUTE?

1. Pastors feel isolated, and many are leaving the ministry.
2. Moral failure is at an epidemic stage for ministers, church leaders, and members.
3. The demands of ministry far exceed what the pastor can handle.
4. Many pastors are unable to receive formal education and also lack resources to lead their church.
5. While many churches are declining, those that are growing have specific Biblical characteristics. These basic Biblical purposes can be taught to godly leaders to help them lead their churches to health and growth.
