What Are We Learning

Early Literacy Skills- We do many things to incorporate literacy skills into our day. From letter recognition and phonics to tracking and much more. This month we will put emphasis in strengthening these skills while playing games and singing songs. **At Home** I'd like to encourage you to play rhyming games with your children. If you need help getting started, Dr. Seuss books can help both you and your child have fun with this great early reading skill.

Math- This month we will be sorting, graphing and patterning everything from our snacks to our opinions. The children will be guided to observe and think logically, to make connections and become problem solvers.

At Home Look for, talk about and make patterns in everything from layer cakes and veggie trays to day and night. You can also give children a pile of coins to play with and pattern. You can tie literacy in by sorting and patterning words by their first letter.
