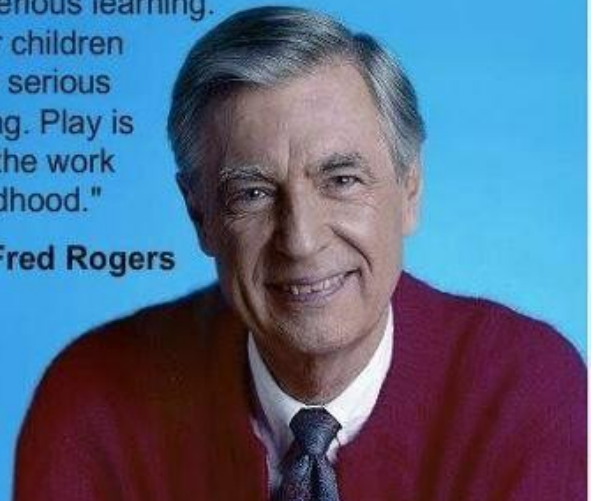


OCTOBER IN THE COOL PRE-K
