# Welcome, Guests!

#### Friends,

We are glad you are here with us and hope you sense God's presence in worship today. If there is any way we can be of help to you, don't hesitate to ask. Here are a few of the questions we often hear from our guests when they first visit:

- ~ How long is the worship service here at Faith? Our worship services typically run 60 to 70 minutes.
- ~ How can I introduce myself? We'd love to meet you after the service; don't hesitate to introduce yourself! You can also visit our webpage (www.faithpresby.org), and click on the "I'm New" tab and then the "Introduce Yourself" button. This is a great way to let the pastoral staff know who you are and how we might welcome and serve you.
- ~ I have kids. Are they welcome here? Absolutely! We love the sounds of children in the sanctuary. During the children's message at the 9:00 a.m. worship service, kids up to 6<sup>th</sup> grade are invited to come up front to listen in. Having them stay with you to listen is also fine. After the children's message, children are invited down the hall to Room 4 (grades 3 to 6) and Room 5 (Pre-K to 2nd grade) with our children's staff. Nursery care is available throughout the 9:00 a.m. worship service in Room 7.
- ~ **Are there classes for adults?** Yes. Check the bulletin and listen for announcements in worship about upcoming classes. We currently have in-person and online classes.
- ~ What if I have trouble hearing the service? If you have difficulty hearing, please ask one of our ushers for a personal receiver for the hearing impaired. Also, a T-Loop hearing-assist system is available in the back four pews on the right side of the sanctuary. Set your hearing aid to the "T" setting.
- ~ How can I find out more information about Faith? Feel free to speak to any of us and if we can't answer your questions, we'll find somebody who can. Our website is a great source of information: <a href="www.faithpresby.org">www.faithpresby.org</a>. Also, *This Week @ Faith* is a weekly email that goes out on Mondays with information about upcoming opportunities and activities. Email Laura Anderson in our office at <a href="mailto:landerson@faithpresby.org">landerson@faithpresby.org</a> if you'd like to be included on the email distribution list.
- ~What if I'm interested in exploring membership or deeper involvement at Faith? "Pursue what makes for peace...." - Romans 14:19


Although many of us long for peace in our world, in our neighborhoods and in our homes, on our own we have no hope of creating true and lasting peace. 
#### Come Celebrate Ron Next Sunday!

Do you find it strange that these days, everybody wants to be a leader, but nobody wants



to be a follower? Jesus asked *everybody* to become a follower and didn't ask *anybody* to become a leader.

Maybe we need to re-define the word "follower." We have all kinds of stereotypes about leaders as strong, healthy and courageous, while followers seem compliant, lacking in choice and freedom. And that is not at all what Jesus had in mind when he offered people the opportunity to follow him.

You are invited to an eight-week class exploring specific practices through which we can follow the Way of Jesus. We will practice ways to Be with Him; Become like Him; and Do as He did.

## **Rise Against Hunger**

#### Saturday, November 15, 2025, in Link Hall, 9:00 a.m. to Noon

Rise Against Hunger (RAH) is a fun and fast-paced food-packing event that the whole family can participate in. There are jobs, both sitting and standing, for almost everyone, regardless of age or physical ability. Last year we packaged 10,000 meals with time to spare. This year our goal is bolder—20,000 meals! We hope you will join us as, together, we fight against hunger.



Here is some important and helpful information to know:

- **Registration is now open!** Use the QR code at right to register. (There will also be a direct link sent in Monday's "This Week @ Faith" email.)
- You must sign up in advance! The amount of food that RAH sends us to package depends on the number of folks who register. If many people who are not registered show up to help, we finish early and have idle hands that could otherwise be engaged with packaging more food for hungry people. Note that when you register, you can indicate how many members of your immediate household are coming—just one registration for your whole family. Easy!



- Whether or not you can participate in the event, **you may also donate to the cause.** While the South Sacramento Rotary and Faith's own Mission team have both committed funds to this effort, any further funds donated will increase the amount of food that RAH sends us and, therefore, the total amount of food that we can package. If you would like to participate by donating, you may do so on the registration page using the same QR code at right. Or, if you prefer, you may write a check payable to Faith Presbyterian Church, with "Rise Against Hunger" on the memo line.
- The deadline to register and/or to donate funds is Friday, November 7. The deadline is needed to allow RAH sufficient time to order and deliver the food prior to our event.
- Please pray! In addition to any participation you may be able to offer through packing and/or donating, we would really love for everyone to join us in praying for a smooth and successful event here at Faith, as well as for God's protection and provision for all in our world who suffer the scourge of hunger.

# **Message Notes**

Life Is Stewardship Part 3—Salt and Light: Sharing What We Have Been Given

#### Questions to Consider...

The following questions and scriptures are provided for Life Groups and individuals who want to reflect further on today's message.

- 1. Read Matthew 5:13-16 again, perhaps out loud and slowly. Is there a word or phrase that stands out? Notice and pay attention to what God might be saying to you.
- 2. What does the image of salt and light represent in this passage? Why do you think Jesus used these particular images?
- 3. Consider the importance of salt in our lives. What is it used for and why is it so significant? Connect these with our own importance and significance as disciples. How are you "salty"?
- 4. Consider the importance of light in our lives. What is it used for and why is it so significant? Connect these ... What is your light? How do you shine your light?
- 5. What doubts arise in you as you think about being the light of the world and the salt of the earth? What fears or worries arise in you when you consider Jesus' words applying to you?
- 6. Are there ways you are hiding your light "under a basket" or not allowing others to know Jesus through you? How can you increase your salt and light impact in the world?
- 7. Encourage one another, how do you see others shining their light or adding "salt" to life? Reflect to each other, as in a mirror, how you see love shining and adding salt to the world through them. Give thanks to God for his salt and light shining through us.



#### Table to Table: Something for kids and adults to consider together

What did Jesus mean when he said, "you are the salt of the earth; you are the light of the world"? Where do the salt and light come from? What happens when people experience our "salt" and "light"? How can our family add more "salt" and "light" to our world?

# **Meeting With God This Week**

#### To help you LISTEN to God...

For your continued times of meeting with God daily, we offer the following passages from God's Word for your reflection. If you need a Bible, let us know and we'll give you one. We encourage you to keep a journal at hand to write down what you hear as you listen to God's Word. If you are new to all this, these steps may help you get started:

Invite - Find a time and space where you can have at least fifteen minutes of privacy and silence. Begin by taking a moment to simply ask God to meet you. Expect God to answer your prayer and show up.

**Scripture** - Read slowly through the passage for the day (we offer suggestions below). Read it again, if you like. Pay attention to phrases or ideas that particularly strike you.

Listen and Reflect - Use a journal to write down what you hear God saying in these verses. What is God telling you about himself? What is God telling you about your life? What is God telling you he wants you to do or to do differently? What questions are raised? What promises are revealed? Write what you hear.

Respond - Use the 3 R's. #1 - Rejoice! What have I heard from God which causes me to praise God and give thanks? Pray accordingly. #2—Repent. What have I heard from God that brings to light sin in my life or change that needs to take place? #3—Request. What have I heard from God that informs the way I pray for myself and others? (The guide in the column to the right, "To Help You Speak with God," may be useful as you pray for others this week.)
