Welcome, Guests!

Friends,

We are glad you are here with us and hope you sense God's presence in worship today. If there is any way we can be of help to you, don't hesitate to ask. Here are a few of the questions we often hear from our guests when they first visit:

- ~ How long is the worship service here at Faith? Our worship services typically run 60 to 70 minutes.
- ~ How can I introduce myself? We'd love to meet you after the service; don't hesitate to introduce yourself! You can also visit our webpage (www.faithpresby.org), and click on the "I'm New" tab and then the "Introduce Yourself" button. This is a great way to let the pastoral staff know who you are and how we might welcome and serve you.
- ~ I have kids. Are they welcome here? Absolutely! We love the sounds of children in the sanctuary. During the children's message at the 9:00 a.m. worship service, kids up to 6th grade are invited to come up front to listen in. Having them stay with you to listen is also fine. After the children's message, children are invited down the hall to Room 4 (grades 3 to 6) and Room 5 (Pre-K to 2nd grade) with our children's staff. Nursery care is available throughout the 9:00 a.m. worship service in Room 7.
- ~ **Are there classes for adults?** Yes. Check the bulletin and listen for announcements in worship about upcoming classes. We currently have in-person and online classes.
- ~ What if I have trouble hearing the service? If you have difficulty hearing, please ask one of our ushers for a personal receiver for the hearing impaired. Also, a T-Loop hearing-assist system is available in the back four pews on the right side of the sanctuary. Set your hearing aid to the "T" setting.
- ~ How can I find out more information about Faith? Feel free to speak to any of us and if we can't answer your questions, we'll find somebody who can. Our website is a great source of information: www.faithpresby.org. Also, *This Week @ Faith* is a weekly email that goes out on Mondays with information about upcoming opportunities and activities. Email Laura Anderson in our office at landerson@faithpresby.org if you'd like to be included on the email distribution list.
- ~What if I'm interested in exploring membership or deeper involvement at Faith? If you'd like to know more about becoming a member at Faith, or want to understand how you can begin or continue to grow in your Christian faith, we encourage you to contact one of our pastors. You can call the church office at (916) 428-3439 or email one of our staff members. (Email addresses are available on our webpage and further on in this bulletin.) We'd love to meet you and find out how

we can be of help.

Life Groups are small groups (4-12) of people who meet weekly for Bible study, prayer and community. These






You are invited to join us for this class that explores specific practices through which we can follow the Way of Jesus. We will practice ways to Be with Him; Become like Him; and Do as He did.

Rise Against Hunger



November 15th is shaping up to be a big day for good causes! Questions to Consider...

The following questions and scriptures are provided for Life Groups and individuals who want to reflect further on today's message.

- 1. Read Matthew 10:9-15. Pay attention to Jesus' instructions here. What do you notice?
- 2. Which part of Jesus' instructions to the disciples seems most applicable to us today? Which part seems least applicable? In general, do you think these instructions apply to us?
- 3. When the disciples found people who seemed worthy (i.e., receptive), they were called to let their peace come up on those people. What would this look like today? How do we "extend the peace of God's blessing" to others we sense are receptive to receiving it? Be as specific as you can.
- 4. Describe somebody in your life who, at this point, seems like a "person of peace."
- 5. Are you known by people you know outside the church as the "Jesus guy" or the "Jesus lady"? Would you like to be known as such? How might you make this happen?
- 6. Why do you think Jesus tells his disciples to wipe the dust off their feet as they leave those who are unreceptive to the gospel? What would this "wiping of dust" look like in our context?
- 7. What excuses do you tend to come up with when faced with Jesus' call to go and share the Christian gospel with others? How do you imagine Jesus responding to those excuses?
- 8. How has this teaching/message changed your view on evangelism?



Table to Table: Something for kids and adults to consider together

Parents/adults, share with your kids about who it was in the past who first shared the gospel with you. How did that happen? How did you receive it?

For your continued times of meeting with God daily, we offer the following passages from God's Word for your reflection. If you need a Bible, let us know and we'll give you one. We encourage you to keep a journal at hand to write down what you hear as you listen to God's Word. If you are new to all this, these steps may help you get started:

Invite - Find a time and space where you can have at least fifteen minutes of privacy and silence. Begin by taking a moment to simply ask God to meet you. Expect God to answer your prayer and show up.

Scripture - Read slowly through the passage for the day (we offer suggestions below). Read it again, if you like. Pay attention to phrases or ideas that particularly strike you.

Listen and Reflect - Use a journal to write down what you hear God saying in these verses. What is God telling you about himself? What is God telling you about your life? What is God telling you he wants you to do or to do differently? What questions are raised? What promises are revealed? Write what you hear.

Respond - Use the 3 R's. #1 - Rejoice! What have I heard from God which causes me to praise God and give thanks? Pray accordingly. #2—Repent. What have I heard from God that brings to light sin in my life or change that needs to take place? #3—Request. What have I heard from God that informs the way I pray for myself and others? (The guide in the column to the right, "To Help You Speak with God," may be useful as you pray for others this week.)
