Friends,

We are glad you are here with us and hope you sense God's presence in worship today. If there is any way we can be of help to you, don't hesitate to ask. Here are a few of the questions we often hear from our guests when they first visit:

- ~ How long is the worship service here at Faith? Our worship services typically run 60 to 70 minutes.
- ~ How can I introduce myself? We'd love to meet you after the service; don't hesitate to introduce yourself! You can also visit our webpage (www.faithpresby.org), and click on the "I'm New" tab and then the "Introduce Yourself" button. This is a great way to let the pastoral staff know who you are and how we might welcome and serve you. Also, stop by the Welcome Center on the way out. We have a gift waiting for you there!
- ~ I have kids. Are they welcome here? Absolutely! We love the sounds of children in the sanctuary. During the children's message at the 9:00 a.m. worship service, kids up to 6th grade are invited to come up front to listen in. Having them stay with you to listen is also fine. After the children's message, children are invited down the hall to Room 4 (grades 3 to 6) and Room 5 (Pre-K to 2nd grade) with our children's staff. Nursery care is available throughout the 9:00 a.m. worship service in Room 7.
- ~ Are there classes for adults? Yes. Check the bulletin and listen for announcements in worship about upcoming classes. We currently have in-person and online classes.
- ~ What if I have trouble hearing the service? If you have difficulty hearing, please ask one of our ushers for a personal receiver for the hearing impaired. Also, a T-Loop hearing-assist system is available in the back four pews on the right side of the sanctuary. Set your hearing aid to the "T" setting.
- ~ How can I find out more information about Faith? Feel free to speak to any of us and if we can't answer your questions, we'll find somebody who can. Our website is a great source of information: www.faithpresby.org. Also, This Week @ Faith is a weekly email that goes out on Mondays with information about upcoming opportunities and activities. Email Laura Anderson in our office at landerson@faithpresby.org if you'd like to be included on the email distribution list.
- ~What if I'm interested in exploring membership or deeper involvement at Faith? I'm new here



Questions to Consider...

The following questions and scriptures are provided for Life Groups and individuals who want to reflect further on today's message.

- 1. Read Matthew 10:40-42 once again. What is the main point of this part of Jesus' teaching?
- 2. Personalize what Jesus is saying here. When you go out to represent Jesus in this world, if people, knowing you come in his name, welcome you then they welcome Jesus. And if they welcome Jesus, they welcome God. On the flip side, if they reject you, then they ultimately reject God. What are the implications here?
- 3. Do you see yourself as an agent of Christ in this world? If so, how so? If not, why not?
- 4. Who is a person in your life right now who is not a Christian, knows you are a Christian, and regularly extends hospitality to you anyway? How do you apply Jesus' teaching here to that relationship?
- 5. Are you one of the "little ones" Jesus speaks about here? Though you may not feel significant in this world, is it possible that Jesus might use you to be one through whom others find their reward in him?
- 6. After having spent the last seven weeks reflecting on what Jesus teaches disciples about going out into the world to bear witness to him, how are you going to think and live differently from now on? What is the main thing that has changed for you?
- 7. What steps do you think our congregation needs to take to make sure that we are a church that is constantly looking to have Jesus send us out to "ripe fields"? What could we do differently to become more outreach focused?
- 8. As a Life Group or family, how can you make sure that your focus isn't always primarily inward, and that in your hearts, conversations and prayers, you also keep focused on those outside the church that Jesus wants to reach with the gospel? Be as specific as you can.

Meeting With God This Week

To help you LISTEN to God...

For your continued times of meeting with God daily, we offer the following passages from God's Word for your reflection. If you need a Bible, let us know and we'll give you one. We encourage you to keep a journal at hand to write down what you hear as you listen to God's Word. If you are new to all this, these steps may help you get started:

Invite - Find a time and space where you can have at least fifteen minutes of privacy and silence. Begin by taking a moment to simply ask God to meet you. Expect God to answer your prayer and show up.

Scripture - Read slowly through the passage for the day (we offer suggestions below). Read it again, if you like. Pay attention to phrases or ideas that particularly strike you.

Listen and Reflect - Use a journal to write down what you hear God saying in these verses. What is God telling you about himself? What is God telling you about your life? What is God telling you he wants you to do or to do differently? What questions are raised? What promises are revealed? Write what you hear.

Respond - Use the 3 R's. #1 - Rejoice! What have I heard from God which causes me to praise God and give thanks? Pray accordingly. #2—Repent. What have I heard from God that brings to light sin in my life or change that needs to take place? #3—Request. What have I heard from God that informs the way I pray for myself and others? (The guide in the column to the right, "To Help You Speak with God," may be useful as you pray for others this week.)
