# Welcome, Guests!

#### Friends,

We are glad you are here with us and hope you sense God's presence in worship today. If there is any way we can be of help to you, don't hesitate to ask. Here are a few of the questions we often hear from our guests when they first visit:

- ~ How long is the worship service here at Faith? Our worship services typically run 60 to 70 minutes.
- ~ How can I introduce myself? We'd love to meet you after the service; don't hesitate to introduce yourself! You can also visit our webpage (www.faithpresby.org), and click on the "I'm New" tab and then the "Introduce Yourself" button. This is a great way to let the pastoral staff know who you are and how we might welcome and serve you.
- ~ I have kids. Are they welcome here? Absolutely! We love the sounds of children in the sanctuary. During the children's message at the 9:00 a.m. worship service, kids up to 6<sup>th</sup> grade are invited to come up front to listen in. Having them stay with you to listen is also fine. After the children's message, children are invited down the hall to Room 4 (grades 3 to 6) and Room 5 (Pre-K to 2nd grade) with our children's staff. Nursery care is available throughout the 9:00 a.m. worship service in Room 7.
- ~ **Are there classes for adults?** Yes. Check the bulletin and listen for announcements in worship about upcoming classes. We currently have in-person and online classes.
- ~ What if I have trouble hearing the service? If you have difficulty hearing, please ask one of our ushers for a personal receiver for the hearing impaired. Also, a T-Loop hearing-assist system is available in the back four pews on the right side of the sanctuary. Set your hearing aid to the "T" setting.
- ~ How can I find out more information about Faith? Feel free to speak to any of us and if we can't answer your questions, we'll find somebody who can. Our website is a great source of information: <a href="www.faithpresby.org">www.faithpresby.org</a>. Also, *This Week @ Faith* is a weekly email that goes out on Mondays with information about upcoming opportunities and activities. Email Laura Anderson in our office at <a href="mailto:landerson@faithpresby.org">landerson@faithpresby.org</a> if you'd like to be included on the email distribution list.
- ~What if I'm interested in exploring membership or deeper involvement at Faith? 
Life Groups are small groups (4-12) of people who meet weekly for Bible study, prayer and community. These

<sup>16</sup> "See, I am sending you out like sheep into the midst of wolves; so be wise as serpents and innocent as doves. <sup>17</sup> Beware of them, for they will hand you over to councils and flog you in their synagogues; <sup>18</sup> and you will be dragged before governors and kings because of me, as a testimony to them and the Gentiles. <sup>19</sup> When they hand you over, do not worry about how you are to speak or what you are to say; for what you are to say will be given to you at that time; <sup>20</sup> for it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you. <sup>21</sup> Brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child, and children will rise against parents and have them put to death; <sup>22</sup> and you will be hated by all because of my name. But the one who endures to the end will be saved. <sup>23</sup> When they persecute you in one town, flee to the next; for truly I tell you, you will not have gone through all the towns of Israel before the Son of Man comes.

<sup>24</sup> "A disciple is not above the teacher, nor a slave above the master; <sup>25</sup> it is enough for the disciple to be like the teacher, and the slave like the master. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebul, how much more will they malign those of his household!

<sup>26</sup> "So have no fear of them; for nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered, and nothing secret that will not become known. <sup>27</sup> What I say to you in the dark, tell in the light; and what you hear whispered, proclaim from the housetops. <sup>28</sup> Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell. <sup>29</sup> Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. <sup>30</sup> And even the hairs of your head are all counted. <sup>31</sup> So do not be afraid; you are of more value than many sparrows.

<sup>32</sup> "Everyone therefore who acknowledges me before others, I also will acknowledge before my Father in heaven; <sup>33</sup> but whoever denies me before others, I also will deny before my Father in heaven."

#### Questions to Consider...

The following questions and scriptures are provided for Life Groups and individuals who want to reflect further on today's message.

- 1. Read Matthew 10:16-25. Listen for what speaks to you or surprises you in this section of the Scripture this week.
- 2. When Jesus says that he is sending us out as "sheep among wolves," how does that shape or change the way you think about following him?
- 3. Has it been your own experience that trouble is the "habitat" of discipleship? Can you remember a time when sharing your faith or standing up for truth brought rejection or at least misunderstanding?
- 4. How might John 16:33 (on the front of the bulletin) be a helpful link in understanding this part of Jesus' words (vv. 16-25) and introducing the next part (vv. 26-33)?
- 5. Now read verses 26 to 33, the rest of this week's passage. Listen for the shift in tone and message of Jesus' words. What do you notice?
- 6. Dale Bruner said, "Trouble is the habitat; trust is the habit." Are there any *habits of trust* that have sustained you when trouble comes your way? How might you lean into a new habit to build trust in this season?
- 7. Just as Jesus helped Peter reclaim his missionary heart on the beach in John 20, how might Jesus be inviting you (and our community) into a grace-filled reunion of who we were meant to be in this call to missionary discipleship?

## **Meeting With God This Week**

#### To help you LISTEN to God...

For your continued times of meeting with God daily, we offer the following passages from God's Word for your reflection. If you need a Bible, let us know and we'll give you one. We encourage you to keep a journal at hand to write down what you hear as you listen to God's Word. If you are new to all this, these steps may help you get started:

Invite - Find a time and space where you can have at least fifteen minutes of privacy and silence. Begin by taking a moment to simply ask God to meet you. Expect God to answer your prayer and show up.

**Scripture** - Read slowly through the passage for the day (we offer suggestions below). Read it again, if you like. Pay attention to phrases or ideas that particularly strike you.

Listen and Reflect - Use a journal to write down what you hear God saying in these verses. What is God telling you about himself? What is God telling you about your life? What is God telling you he wants you to do or to do differently? What questions are raised? What promises are revealed? Write what you hear.

Respond - Use the 3 R's. #1 - Rejoice! What have I heard from God which causes me to praise God and give thanks? Pray accordingly. #2—Repent. What have I heard from God that brings to light sin in my life or change that needs to take place? #3—Request. What have I heard from God that informs the way I pray for myself and others? (The guide in the column to the right, "To Help You Speak with God," may be useful as you pray for others this week.)
