Welcome, Guests!

Friends,

We are glad you are here with us and hope you sense God's presence in worship today. If there is any way we can be of help to you, don't hesitate to ask. Here are a few of the questions we often hear from our guests when they first visit:

- ~ **How long is the worship service here at Faith?** Our worship services typically run 60 to 70 minutes.
- ~ **How can I introduce myself?** We'd love to meet you after the service; don't hesitate to introduce yourself! You can also visit our webpage (www.faithpresby.org), and click on the "I'm New" tab and then the "Introduce Yourself" button. This is a great way to let the pastoral staff know who you are and how we might welcome and serve you. Also, stop by the Welcome Center on the way out. We have a gift waiting for you there! And if you need a Bible, we can offer you one there as well.
- ~ **I have kids. Are they welcome here?** Absolutely! We love the sounds of children in the sanctuary. During the children's message at the 9:00 a.m. worship service, kids up to 6th grade are invited to come up front to listen in. Having them stay with you to listen is also fine. After the children's message, children are invited down the hall to Room 4 (grades 3 to 6) and Room 5 (Pre-K to 2nd grade) with our children's staff. Nursery care is available throughout the 9:00 a.m. worship service in Room 7.
- ~ **Are there classes for adults?** Yes. Check the bulletin and listen for announcements in worship about upcoming classes. We currently have in-person and online classes.
- ~ **What if I have trouble hearing the service?** If you have difficulty hearing, please ask one of our ushers for a personal receiver for the hearing impaired. Also, a T-Loop hearing-assist system is available in the back four pews on the right side of the sanctuary. Set your hearing aid to the "T" setting.
- ~ **How can I find out more information about Faith?** Feel free to speak to any of us and if we can't answer your questions, we'll find somebody who can. Our website is a great source of information: www.faithpresby.org. Also, *This Week @ Faith* is a weekly email that goes out on Mondays with information about upcoming opportunities and activities. Email Laura Anderson in our office at landerson@faithpresby.org if you'd like to be included on the email distribution list.
- ~ **What if I'm interested in exploring membership or deeper involvement at Faith?** If you'd like to know more about becoming a member at Faith, or want to understand how you can begin or continue to grow in your Christian faith, we encourage you to contact one of our pastors. We'd love to meet you and find out how we can be of help.

Life Together

What is Life Together? Life Together is a five-week interactive course geared toward bringing together people who want to grow with one another to be formed more fully as devoted followers of Jesus Christ here in this community of Faith. The course will include a balance of group gatherings and individual spiritual practices. The application to everyday life will be intensely practical. We explore both key doctrines and disciplines of the Christian faith, both of which are essential for spiritual growth.

Is this course for you? Ask yourself the following questions:

- Have you found yourself recently interested in Jesus and how you can have a personal and vibrant relationship with him as Savior and Lord?
- Are you tired of feeling “stuck” or “stalled” in your Christian faith?
- Are you finding it difficult, if not impossible, to become the sort of person you sense God made you to become?
- Are you new (or maybe not so new) to this congregation and eager to connect with others in this faith community at a deeper level?
- Are you interested in considering the commitment of membership here at Faith?

When is this course offered? Life Together will be offered on Sunday evenings from 6:00-7:30 p.m. on the following dates: **March 1, 8, 15, 22, 29.** A celebration dinner will be held at the end (date TBD). Though participants are encouraged to be present for every session, teachings can be recorded when needed. Sign-ups are taken well in advance. 1. Read Psalm 1 again. Read it slowly. Remember that this Psalm is the gateway to all the Psalms. What stands out to you? What image strikes you here?
2. What does it mean to be blessed? How does one know he or she is blessed? How is being blessed different from being happy? Or is it different?
3. Consider the pathway that starts by following the advice of the wicked and ends with sitting in the seat of mockers. Is this a progression? How have you seen this play out in your own life?
4. Have you found it true for you that the longer you listen to a lie, the more you come to believe it? Before jumping to how you see this in others, examine your own life and your own vulnerability here.
5. Reflect carefully on verse 2. What are we being told here? How does a person come to delight in the law/Word of the Lord?
6. The psalmist declares that the blessed person who learns to delight in God's Word will become like a flourishing tree which bears fruit in season. What do you think that fruit symbolizes?
7. As you look out on the world today, do you remain a person filled with hope? Why or why not?
8. What is the main thing you sense that Christ is teaching you through this message? How will that change the way you think or live?



Table to Table: Something for kids and adults to consider together

Read Psalm 1 together again as a family. Remember that the Psalms are a book of prayers. How can you turn this Psalm into a prayer?

Meeting With God This Week

To help you LISTEN to God...

For your continued times of meeting with God daily, we offer the following passages from God's Word for your reflection. If you need a Bible, let us know and we'll give you one. We encourage you to keep a journal at hand to write down what you hear as you listen to God's Word. If you are new to all this, these steps may help you get started:

Invite - Find a time and space where you can have at least fifteen minutes of privacy and silence. Begin by taking a moment to simply ask God to meet you. Expect God to answer your prayer and show up.

Scripture - Read slowly through the passage for the day (we offer suggestions below). Read it again, if you like. Pay attention to phrases or ideas that particularly strike you.

Listen and Reflect - Use a journal to write down what you hear God saying in these verses. What is God telling you about himself? What is God telling you about your life? What is God telling you he wants you to do or to do differently? What questions are raised? What promises are revealed? Write what you hear.

Respond - Use the 3 R's. **#1 - Rejoice!** What have I heard from God which causes me to praise God and give thanks? Pray accordingly. **#2—Repent.** What have I heard from God that brings to light sin in my life or change that needs to take place? **#3—Request.** What have I heard from God that informs the way I pray for myself and others? (The guide in the column to the right, "To Help You Speak with God," may be useful as you pray for others this week.)

LENT & EASTER AT FAITH

Lent is the 40-day period of renewal and preparation before Easter. It begins on Ash Wednesday. For hundreds of years Lent has been an important season for Christians to meditate, study, pray, participate in spiritual disciplines, and renew their vows to the Lord as they strive to increase their understanding of Christ's sacrifice and resurrection. Our hope is that you, and others you invite, will participate fully in the Lenten activities offered here at Faith. May God renew us and prepare us to celebrate again all that he did for us on the cross and at the empty tomb! All worship services will be in person, and all those at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. will be livestreamed.



Ash Wednesday Dinner & Worship (February 18 — dinner at 5:30 p.m., worship at 7:00 p.m.)

Join us for dinner in Link Hall at 5:30 and then worship in the sanctuary at 7:00. This service initiates the season of Lent and includes the imposition of ashes and the celebration of the Lord's Supper.

Wednesday Evenings in Lent: Immersion in Scripture (February 25 to March 25 at 7:00 p.m.)

We will gather these Wednesday evenings in Lent for a time of contemplative worship together. Each Wednesday, we will take time to read through all (or most) of a book of the Bible together. Readings will be interspersed with silence, song and prayer. This year we will read through Ruth (2/25), I Timothy (3/4), Lamentations (3/11), James (3/18), and the Gospel of Mark (a special 2-hour service on 3/25). We will also share the Lord's Supper together each week.

Palm/Passion Sunday Worship (March 29 — 9:00 & 11:00 a.m.)

We celebrate the beginning of Holy Week together in worship.

Maundy Thursday Dinner & Worship (April 2 — dinner at 5:30 p.m., worship at 7:00 p.m.)

This service, commemorating the Last Supper, is an important time to gather around the Lord's Table. We will gather for dinner in Link Hall at 5:30. Worship begins in the sanctuary at 7:00 p.m.

Good Friday Tenebrae Service (April 3 — 7:00 p.m.)

Tenebrae (Latin for “darkness, shadows”) is a traditional service often held on Good Friday that rehearses the passion of Christ and is characterized by the gradual extinguishing of light. Though an ancient tradition, it is still quite new to us here at Faith, and we are looking forward to experiencing it again this year.
