Friends,

We are glad you are here with us and hope you sense God's presence in worship today. If there is any way we can be of help to you, don't hesitate to ask. Here are a few of the questions we often hear from our guests when they first visit:

- ~ **How long is the worship service here at Faith?** Our worship services typically run 60 to 70 minutes.
- ~ **How can I introduce myself?** We'd love to meet you after the service; don't hesitate to introduce yourself! You can also visit our webpage (www.faithpresby.org), and click on the "I'm New" tab and then the "Introduce Yourself" button. This is a great way to let the pastoral staff know who you are and how we might welcome and serve you. Also, stop by the Welcome Center on the way out. We have a gift waiting for you there! And if you need a Bible, we can offer you one there as well.
- ~ **I have kids. Are they welcome here?** Absolutely! We love the sounds of children in the sanctuary. During the children's message at the 9:00 a.m. worship service, kids up to 6th grade are invited to come up front to listen in. Having them stay with you to listen is also fine. After the children's message, children are invited down the hall to Room 4 (grades 3 to 6) and Room 5 (Pre-K to 2nd grade) with our children's staff. Nursery care is available throughout the 9:00 a.m. worship service in Room 7.
- ~ **Are there classes for adults?** Yes. Check the bulletin and listen for announcements in worship about upcoming classes. We currently have in-person and online classes.
- ~ **What if I have trouble hearing the service?** If you have difficulty hearing, please ask one of our ushers for a personal receiver for the hearing impaired. Also, a T-Loop hearing-assist system is available in the back four pews on the right side of the sanctuary. Set your hearing aid to the "T" setting.
- ~ **How can I find out more information about Faith?** Feel free to speak to any of us and if we can't answer your questions, we'll find somebody who can. Our website is a great source of information: www.faithpresby.org. Also, *This Week @ Faith* is a weekly email that goes out on Mondays with information about upcoming opportunities and activities. Email Laura Anderson in our office at landerson@faithpresby.org if you'd like to be included on the email distribution list.
- ~ **What if I'm interested in exploring membership or deeper involvement at Faith?** If you'd like to know more about becoming a member at Faith, or want to understand how you can begin or continue to grow in your Christian faith, we encourage you to contact one of our pastors. A Simple Approach to Homiletics: Assembling the Content of a Bible Passage to Facilitate Understanding

June 14, 21, 28

10:15 a.m., Grace Room

Facilitator: Larry Larsen

The Scriptures are recorded in languages spoken today by few people. Therefore, sermons and homilies serve to facilitate understanding. Very briefly, sermons tend to be longer and explore more deeply, while homilies tend to be shorter and explore more simply.

The simple approach to homiletics that we will explore in this class has been used for decades by leaders in Bible Study Fellowship (BSF). Audrey Wetherell Johnson, the founder of BSF, learned this approach, pioneered by Hudson Taylor, while serving with the China Inland Mission.

We will practice homiletics using John 6:1-21, in three parts.

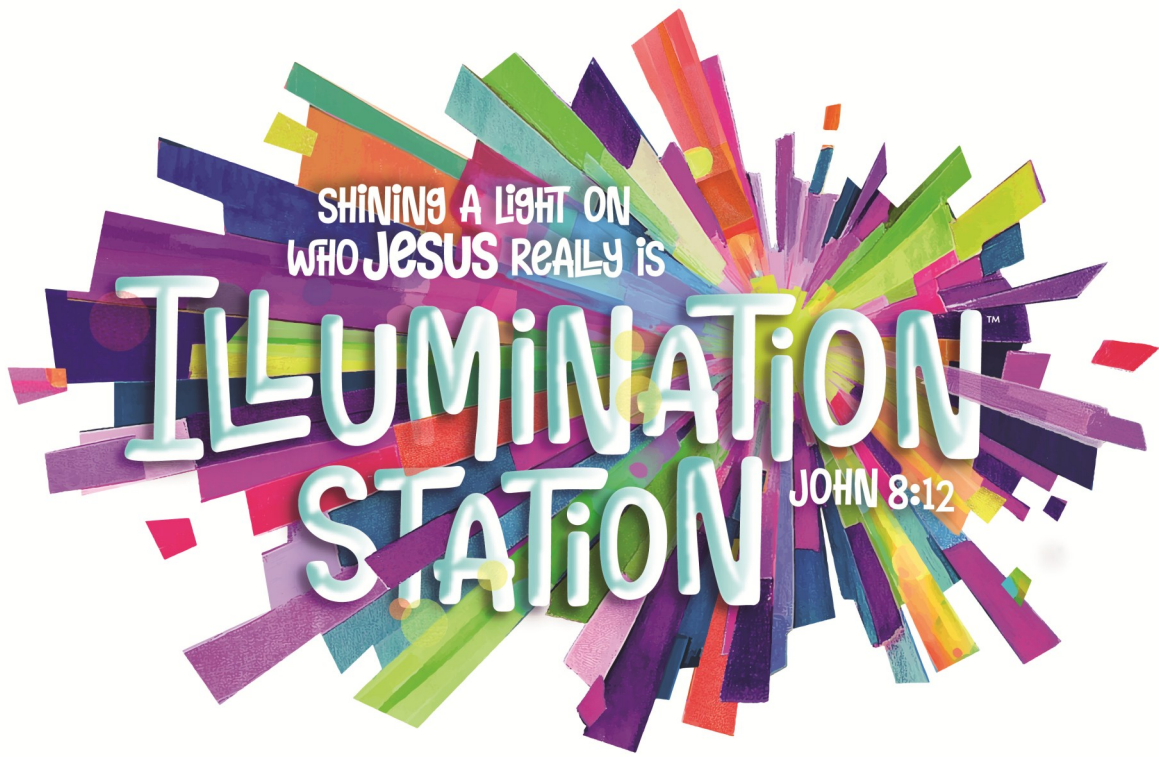


- Sunday morning women's group; meets every week in Room 2 at 10:15 a.m.

As you spend time with the Lord each day, we invite you to add these daily VBS prayer requests and join us in covering the children, families and volunteers this week in prayer.

DAY 1

Pray that participants will understand and believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the promised Son of God. Matthew 16:16

DAY 2

Pray for participants to see Jesus as more than just a good man. He is the perfect Son of God who came to be the Savior of the world. Mark 1:11

DAY 3

Pray participants will understand that everything Jesus said and did showed that He is the powerful Son of God. Matthew 28:18

DAY 4

Ask God to help participants understand that Jesus lived, died, and rose to life to be our Savior, now and forever. Mark 15:39

DAY 5

Pray for the children to understand that Jesus is God's plan for forgiveness. Ask that they be called to respond to Jesus and be bold to act in obedience.

Questions to Consider...

The following questions and scriptures are provided for Life Groups and individuals who want to reflect further on today's message.

1. As you read Galatians 5.13, 22-23, what words or phrases get your attention?
2. When you think of God, do you think of him as gentle? Why or why not? Do you think of Jesus as gentle? Why or why not? When and how have you experienced the gentleness of the Lord?
3. Think of someone you have known whom you would describe as gentle. What about them was gentle? Think of someone who was not gentle, and what about them was not gentle?
4. How would you define gentleness? What kinds of actions would you consider gentle, and what ones not gentle? What words are gentle and what ones are not?
5. Is gentleness valued or considered a virtue in our world today? In the church today? Why or why not?
6. Have you thought of gentleness as a Christian virtue or characteristic to be pursued? Why do you think it is included in the lists of both Jesus and Paul?
7. How might Christians better practice gentleness in our daily lives?



Table to Table: Something for kids and adults to consider together

When you think of God, do you think of him as powerful? What does power look like and sound like and feel like? Do you think of God as gentle? What does gentle look like and sound like and feel like?

Meeting With God This Week

To help you LISTEN to God...

For your continued times of meeting with God daily, we offer the following passages from God's Word for your reflection. If you need a Bible, let us know and we'll give you one. We encourage you to keep a journal at hand to write down what you hear as you listen to God's Word. If you are new to all this, these steps may help you get started:

Invite - Find a time and space where you can have at least fifteen minutes of privacy and silence. Begin by taking a moment to simply ask God to meet you. Expect God to answer your prayer and show up.

Scripture - Read slowly through the passage for the day (we offer suggestions below). Read it again, if you like. Pay attention to phrases or ideas that particularly strike you.

Listen and Reflect - Use a journal to write down what you hear God saying in these verses. What is God telling you about himself? What is God telling you about your life? What is God telling you he wants you to do or to do differently? What questions are raised? What promises are revealed? Write what you hear.

Respond - Use the 3 R's. **#1 - Rejoice!** What have I heard from God which causes me to praise God and give thanks? Pray accordingly. **#2—Repent.** What have I heard from God that brings to light sin in my life or change that needs to take place? **#3—Request.** What have I heard from God that informs the way I pray for myself and others? (The guide in the column to the right, "To Help You Speak with God," may be useful as you pray for others this week.)
