KAIROS Blanket Exercise Mon. Sept. 29; 7-9pm at Huron Christian School, Clinton: Ten years ago the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) released its report with 94 Calls to Action. In 2021, Sept. 30 was officially recognized as a National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. As Canadians and Christians we are challenged to engage with this reconciliation process. Youth, parents and community members are invited to participate in an evening of learning and engagement with active participation in a walk through history as Cindy Stover and Adrian Jacobs facilitate the KAIROS Blanket Exercise using a youth script to give perspective to the current complex realities.
