KAIROS Blanket Exercise Mon. Sept. 29; 7-9pm at Huron Christian School, Clinton: Ten years ago the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) released its report with 94 Calls to Action. In 2021, Sept. 30 was officially recognized as a National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. As Canadians and Christians we are challenged to engage with this reconciliation process.
