DAILY DEVOTIONS FOR THIS WEEK

Monday: Read 2 Corinthians 4:7-18. Believers have the treasure of the gospel in mortal bodies that are like fragile jars of clay. We face suffering and hardship, and our bodies get older and weaker over time. But we should not lose hope because our suffering is temporary and preparing us for eternal glory. God's promise of future glory blunts the pain of present suffering and enables us to live with hope. Find your hope in eternal unseen things, not temporary things you can see.

Tuesday: Read Paul's challenge and encouragement to men in 1 Cor. 16:13-14. He said to be alert to what's happening around you. Stand firm in your faith in Christ no matter what happens. Act like a real man by being strong and doing everything in love. Being a person of faith empowers a man to be strong and love well. God is for you! Trust Him!

Wednesday: Read Romans 5:1-5. Becoming a follower of Jesus not only gives us peace with God, access to His grace, and hope for glory it changes how we view suffering. God doesn't waste it. He leverages it by the power of the Holy Spirit to create greater endurance, character and hope in us. Believing this promise of transformation gives us clarity about what God is doing in times of painful uncertainty. Trust Him!

Thursday: Romans 8:26-27, 34 reveal something amazing about who is praying for every Christ follower. See also Hebrews 7:25. How does it make you feel to know that both the Holy Spirit and Jesus are interceding before God the Father on your behalf? When you don't know how or what to pray, they pray for you. When you give up, they keep praying. When you pray according to your desires, they pray according to God's desires. You are secure in the hands of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Thank them!

Friday: Close this week by reading Romans 8:31-39 several times. Reflect on each of the seven questions Paul asks. God wants you to know the truth about His unlimited, unbreakable love for you. No matter what you go through you can trust that God is for you and loves you forever. You can face any fear with confidence knowing that you can't shake God's love and nothing in the universe can break it. Amen!!
