DAILY DEVOTIONS FOR THIS WEEK

Monday: In a letter to Thomas Nelson on August 20, 1778, General George Washington wrote, *“The hand of Providence has been so conspicuous in [the Revolutionary War], that he must be worse than an infidel that lacks faith, and more than wicked, that has not gratitude enough to acknowledge his obligations.”* Thank God today for His providence in the founding and success of our nation.

Tuesday: In a letter to the Massachusetts Militia on October 11, 1798, President John Adams wrote, *“We have no Government armed with Power capable of contending with human Passions unbridled by morality and Religion. Avarice, Ambition, Revenge or Gallantry, would break the strongest Cords of our Constitution as a Whale goes through a Net. Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.”* Do you consider our current populace to be “a moral and religious people”? Read 2 Chronicles 7:14 and pray that prayer of revival for our nation.

Wednesday: Imagine for a moment that you are about to share the gospel with an unbelieving friend who wants to know how to be saved. How would you explain the gospel using Romans 3:23; 5:8; 6:23 and 10:9-10, 13? Practice this with a friend.

Thursday: In an order to the Continental Army on July 9, 1776, General George Washington wrote, *“The blessing and protection of Heaven are at all times necessary, but especially so in times of public distress and danger. The General hopes and trusts, that every officer and man will endeavor so to live and act as becomes a Christian soldier, defending the dearest rights and liberties of his country.”* How should a Christian live and act in defending the rights and liberties of our country?

Friday: Read Romans 10:11-17. What is God’s plan for people to hear the gospel? Have you responded to God’s call to Live SENT? Does your living SENT include talking to them about the gospel? Don’t settle for inviting people to church. Invite them to trust Jesus? If our generation does not raise up a new generation of Christ followers, we will be the last generation in America!
