DAILY REFLECTIONS ON MISSION AND VISION

Monday: Read Philippians 1:6. What is God working in you? What would it look like for His work in you to be complete? Ask God to give you a vision of His completed work. What next steps do you need to take this year to make progress toward that vision? Write it down and begin work this week on the most strategic step.

Tuesday: Jesus' mission was to turn lost people into fully devoted followers (Luke 19:10; 9:23). What is your life mission? How do you measure success? A life without a mission is a life without purpose. A clear mission/purpose gives you clarity and confidence to avoid distractions, push through discouragement and celebrate success. Ask God to help you write your life mission. Keep it short to be memorable.

Wednesday: Our vision at Canopy Roads is to raise up a new generation of Christ followers by being an outwardly focused church that lives SENT. Make it your goal to commit this to memory. Have you found your part in the vision? It begins by living SENT, because that is everyone's part. Write down the names of 5-10 neighbors, associates, friends or family members with whom you can live SENT this year. Start praying daily for opportunities and look for God at work this week.

Thursday: Read Matthew 9:35-38. As Jesus lived SENT, he saw crowds of people who needed "a shepherd" to lead and help them, but He knew there were not enough "laborers" for the harvest. How are you serving God's work at Canopy Roads, at your job, at your school, in your hobbies, etc.? If you are already serving, pray regularly for more people to serve with you. Invite people God puts in your path.

Friday: Read 2 Timothy 2:1-7. How many generations of Christ followers are mentioned in verse 2? Did you count 4? What "faithful" new or young believers are you investing in? Who could you invite to eat with you, recreate with you, pray with you, learn with you, serve with you, etc.? Jesus and Paul made disciples by doing life with them. You can too.
