DAILY REFLECTIONS ON THE BEST NEWS EVER

Monday

Read Psalm 34:17-18 and Isaiah 43:1-3. God is always present when His children hurt. If you are hurting, confused, discouraged, or disillusioned, ask God to help you sense His presence. Tuesday

Read Jeremiah 29:1-23. What is the context? Who was Jeremiah writing to? Why were they in Babylon (Jer. 25:1-14)? Everyone paid the price of the sinful majority, righteous and unrighteous alike. Read 29:11-13 several times. God told them there was life after loss. Trust God to give you life after your loss. Seek God for it.

Wednesday

Read Hebrews 12:1-11. How does painful discipline show that God loves us? Good parents don't protect their children from all the pain of bad choices. Pain is part of growth because it inspires life change and yields the peaceful fruit of right living. How has God used pain to grow you?

Thursday

Read Genesis 3. This is the story of how paradise was lost by sin. How is this your story too? Adam and Eve were locked out of paradise in a world broken by their own sin. We live in that broken world where pain and loss are inevitable. Do you ever hunger to return to "the garden" and regain the paradise we lost? For believers in Jesus, this dream will become reality. Read Revelation 21:1-22:5. The new city of God in heaven on earth will be spectacular. Notice in 22:1-5 who and what is in the middle of the city. How is it like the garden of Eden (Gen. 2:8-14)?
