DAILY REFLECTIONS ON BELIEF IN THE VIRGIN BIRTH

Monday

Wednesday

- Read Luke 1:26-38. How did Mary respond to the unexpected news from the angel? (v. 38) What did it cost Mary to obey God and submit to His plan? Did she believe it was worth it?
- Reflect on Luke 9:23-27. How has following Jesus cost you?
- Listen to "Weary Traveler" by Jordan St. Cyr.

Thursday

- Read Hebrews 4:11-16. What does it mean to you that our great high priest, Jesus, is able to sympathize with your weaknesses?
 That he was tempted just like you?
- Listen to "Strong Enough" by Matthew West. Reread v. 16 and pray confidently for His mercy and grace in your time of need. He is strong enough for the both of you.

Friday

 Watch or listen to "The Creed" by Rich Mullins. Reflect on the chorus: "And I believe what I believe is what makes me what I am. I did not make it; no, it is making me. It is the very truth of God and not the invention of any man." How are your beliefs about God "making you"? Recite the Apostles' Creed as a prayer.
